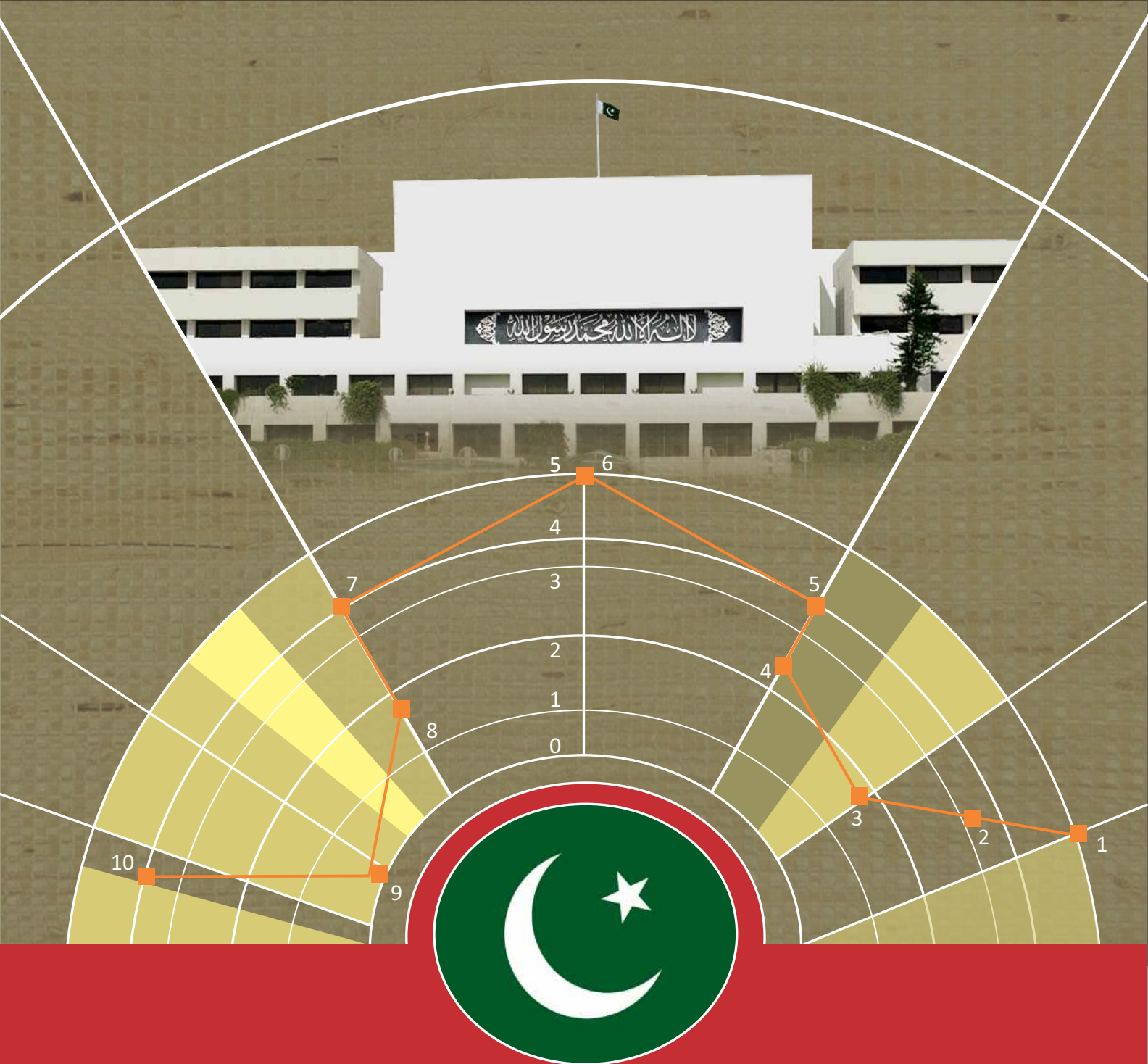

Preface

Last year in 2015, PILDAT conducted a mapping exercise of the political leadership in Pakistan, and produced a list of 21 top leaders of the country who were thought most likely to become Prime Minister of Pakistan in the next 15 years' time. Although evolution of political leadership does not necessarily follow a logical and scientific process, PILDAT attempted to employ a rather scientific framework for the selection of these 21 potential Prime Ministers of Pakistan. This effort was made for the purpose of improving the quality of future leadership by inspiring the identified leaders to place a greater focus on their policy positions and refine their vision about a better Pakistan.

PILDAT has taken a step forward this year and tried to assess the performance of the elected leadership of the Senate of Parliament, traditionally considered the upper house of the parliament. From 2002 onwards, PILDAT has consistently looked at the performance of the Pakistan's Parliament, reviewing it from the citizens' perspective with the aim of enhancing public interest in and engagement with the parliament. This year, we decided to study the performance of the individual Parliamentarians in the Senate of Pakistan during the Thirteenth Parliamentary Year of Senate, March 12, 2015 to March 11, 2016 within the overall context of mapping the future political leadership of Pakistan.

The methodology and framework of assessing the performance of 102 Senators were developed indigenously. The data for preparing the Score Cards was obtained from the two main public sources: The Official Website of the Senate of Pakistan¹ and the 'Report to the People of Pakistan' produced by the Senate.² Senators themselves were also contacted to provide their updated educational and professional details.

The objective behind PILDAT's assessment of the performance of the Honorable Senators of Pakistan is to foster transparency and greater democratic accountability in the country and to help in the mapping exercise for the future political leadership of Pakistan.

We hope that this report and the discourse it generates will contribute to empowering political leadership in Pakistan. This is a first attempt made by PILDAT to assess and rank the performance of Senators, and hence, has a lot of room for improvement. We will welcome comments and suggestions for improvement in the concept, methodology and framework of assessment and presentation of the Senators' Score Cards.

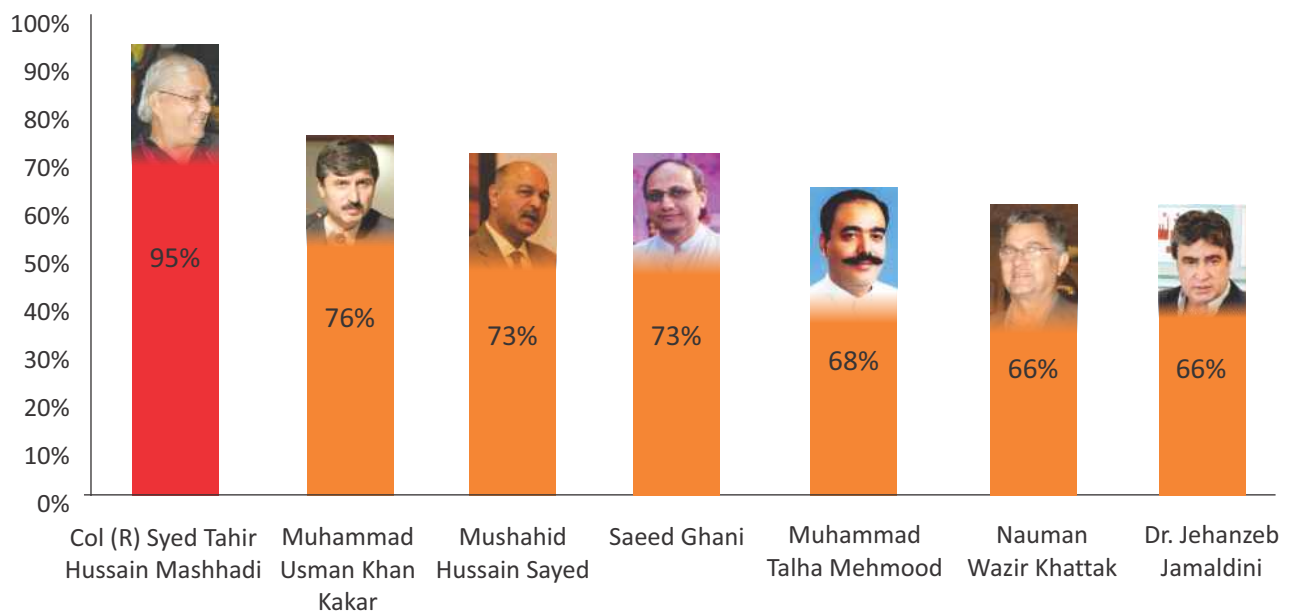
Executive Summary

This report presents an assessment of the individual parliamentary performance of the honourable senators of Pakistan during the Thirteenth Parliamentary Year of the Senate, that is, March 12, 2015 – March 11, 2016. The principal objective behind this evaluation exercise is to foster transparency and greater democratic accountability in the country and to help in the mapping exercise of the future political leadership of Pakistan.

According to the results of this assessment, the following Senators have attained the **Top 5 Ranks**:

1. Senator Col. (R) Tahir Hussain Mashhadi, Sindh, MQM, with 95% overall score
2. Senator Muhammad Usman Kakar, Balochistan, PMAP, with 76% overall score
3. Senator Saeed Ghani, Sindh, PPPP, and Senator Mushahid Hussain Sayed, Federal Capital, PML, both with 73% overall score
4. Senator Muhammad Talha Mehmood, KP, JUI (F), with 68% overall score
5. Senator Nauman Wazir Khattak, KP, PTI, and Senator Dr. Jehanzeb Jamaladini, Balochistan, BNP-M, both with 66% overall score

102 Senators have attained ranks or positions between 1 and 40. The overall average performance score of the Senators is 41%. Average Attendance of Senators in Committee Meetings is 51% and Average Attendance in Plenary Sessions of the Senate is 63.3% (compared to 61% in the National Assembly).

Based on the final scores and the ranks, the top-most performer is **Senator Col. (R) Tahir Hussain Mashhadi** who has been elected from the Sindh province and belongs to the Muttahida Quami Movement (MQM). He can be called '**Senator of the year, 2015-2016**'. Senator Mashhadi has achieved the highest overall score of 95% and secured the **1st position** among the 102 senators whose individual parliamentary performances were evaluated. He is also MQM's parliamentary leader in the Senate.

It is interesting to note that Senators who are all parliamentary party leaders occupy the Top 5 Ranks. Senator

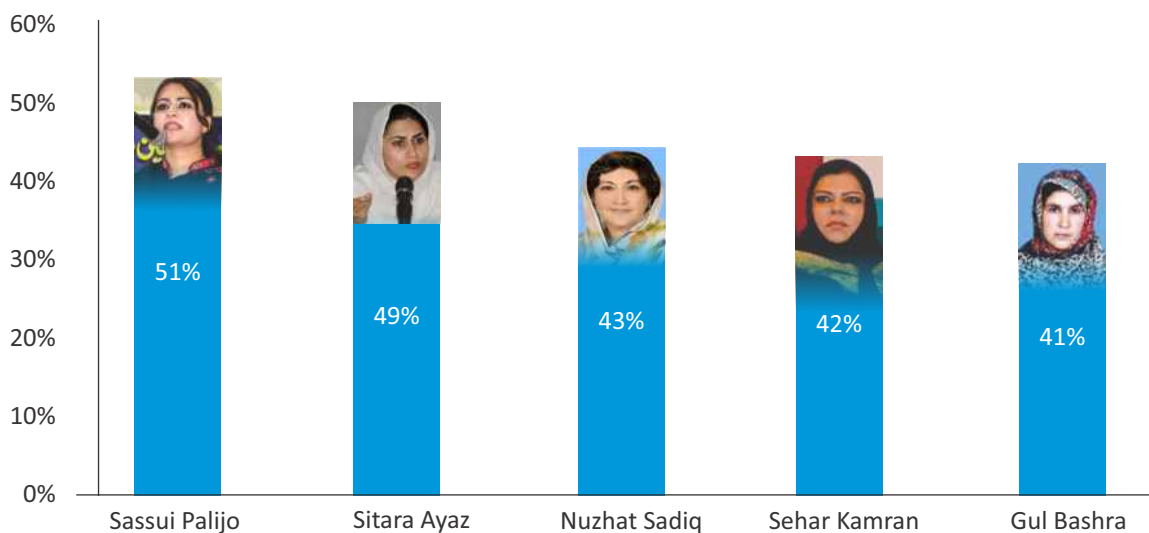
Muhammad Usman Kakar, who has achieved the second highest score of 76%, is the parliamentary leader of the Pakhtunkhwa Milli Awami Party (PMAP) and has been elected from the province of Balochistan; Senator Saeed Ghani, who has achieved the third highest score of 73%, is the parliamentary leader of the Pakistan Peoples Party Parliamentarian (PPP-P) elected from Sindh province; Senator Mushahid Hussain Sayed, who has also achieved the third highest score of 73%, is the parliamentary leader of the Pakistan Muslim League (PML) elected from Islamabad, the federal capital and Senator Muhammad Talha Mehmood, who has achieved the fourth highest score of 68%, is the parliamentary party leader of the Jamiat Ulema-e-Islam-Fazl (JUI-F) elected from KP ; Senator Nauman Wazir Khattak, who has achieved the fifth highest score of 66%, is the parliamentary party leader of the Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) elected from KP and Senator Dr. Jehanzeb Jamaldini, who has also achieved the fifth highest score of 66%, is the parliamentary party leader of the Balochistan National Party-Mengal (BNP-M) elected from Balochistan.

While the Senators from the Federal Capital and the three smaller provinces figure in the top five positions, none of the Senators from the Punjab province could make it to the top five positions.

The **Top 5 Women Senators** are as follows:

- 1) Senator Sassui Palijo (Sindh, PPP-P) with first Position among women senators, an overall rank of 13 and overall score of 51%
- 2) Senator Sitara Ayaz (KP, ANP) with second position among women senators, an overall rank of 15 and overall score of 50%
- 3) Senator Nuzhat Sadiq (Punjab, PML-N) with third position among women senators, an overall rank of 21 and overall score of 43%
- 4) Senator Sehar Kamran (Sindh, PPP-P) with fourth position among women senators, an overall rank of 22 and overall score of 42%
- 5) Senator Gul Bashra (Balochistan, PMAP) with fifth position among women senators, an overall rank of 23 and overall score of 41%

The Honourable **Leader of the House, Senator Raja Muhammad Zafar-ul-Haq** (Punjab, PML-N), attained a score of 62% and is on the **8th position**, which he shares with Senator Syed Muzaffar Hussain Shah from Pakistan Muslim League-Functional (PML-F) elected from Sindh.

The Honourable **Leader of the Opposition, Senator Aitzaz Ahsan** (Sindh, PPP-P), is not far behind with an overall score

of 57%, which is the 10th position.

The Federal Minister for Finance, Revenue, Economic Affairs, Statistics and Privatisation, **Senator Ishaq Dar**, of Pakistan Muslim League-Nawaz (PML-N) attained an overall score of 20% and stands at the 40th position. He is elected from the Punjab province.

Federal Minister for Information, Broadcasting and National Heritage, **Senator Pervaiz Rasheed** (Punjab, PML-N), has attained a score of 27%, which is the 36th position. Federal Minister for Human Rights, **Senator Kamran Michael** (Punjab, PML-N), follows suit with a score of 24%, which is the 37th position.

The performance scorecards of senators presented in this report focused on three main aspects of the parliamentary role of a senator: **Oversight, Legislation and Representation**.

The **Top Performer in Oversight** is Senator Col. (R) Tahir Hussain Mashhadi (Sindh, MQM), with an average score of 4.4 out of 5.

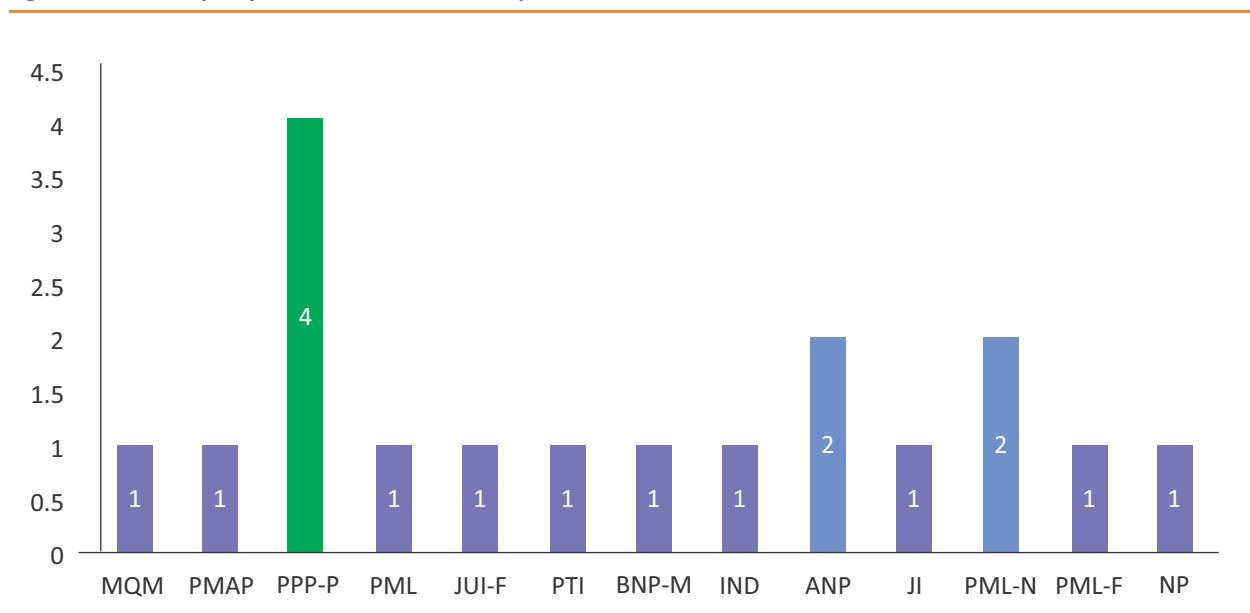
The **Top Performer in Legislation** is Senator Mushahid Hussain Sayed (ICT, PML), with a total of 9 private member's bills introduced of which 8 passed in the Senate during the year.

The **Top Performer in Representation** is Senator Hamza (Punjab, PML-N), with the highest attendance of 97% in the plenary sessions of the Senate.

The **PPP-P** is the **Political Party** with the highest number of top-performing senators. In order to gauge this result, the top 15 positions or ranks were checked for each political party. The PPP has four of its elected leadership in the Senate among the top 15 position holders:

- 1) Senator Saeed Ghani (Sindh, PPPP) on the 3rd position
- 2) Senator Aitzaz Ahsan (Sindh, PPP-P) on the 10th position
- 3) Senator Farhatullah Babar (KP, PPP-P) on the 11th position and
- 4) Senator Sassui Palijo (Sindh, PPP-P) on the 13th position

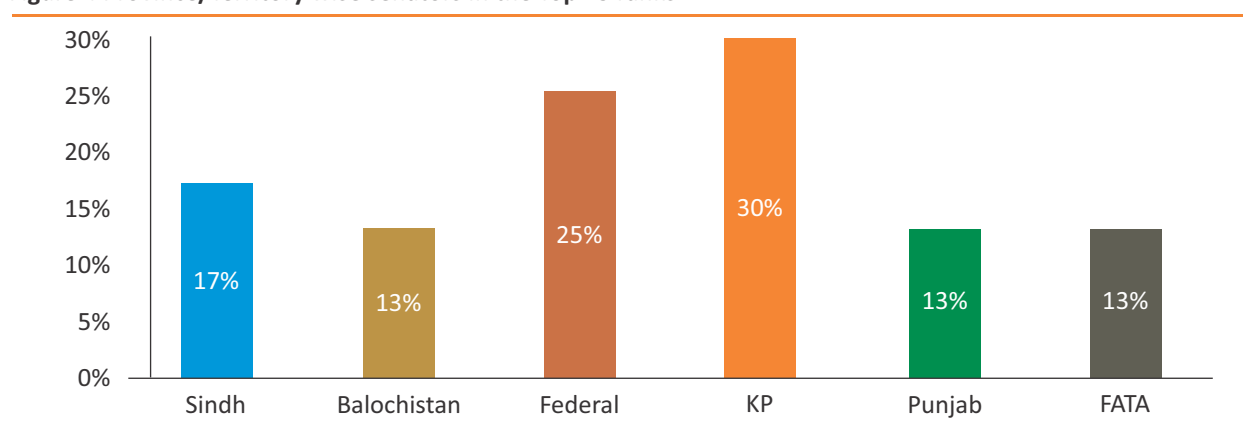
Figure 3: Political party-wise senators in the top 15 ranks



Similarly, the top 15 positions were also checked for the **Province/Territory** with the highest percentage of top-performing senators, which turned out to be the **Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (KP)**. Seven (7) or 30% of senators from KP are among the top 15 position holders:

- 1) Senator Talha Mehmood of the JUI-F on the 4th position
- 2) Senator Nauman Wazir Khattak of the PTI on the 5th position
- 3) Senator Baz Muhammad Khan of the ANP on the 7th position
- 4) Senator Siraj-ul-Haq of the JI on the 7th position
- 5) Senator Farhatullah Babar of the PPP on the 11th position
- 6) Senator Shahi Syed of the ANP on the 14th position
- 7) Senator Sitara Ayaz of the ANP on the 15th position

This report is based on a series of quantitative methods of data collection. An indigenous framework of assessment was devised by PILDAT consisting of **10 parameters** against which data was collected for each Senator. PILDAT extracted information through various means available on the official website of the Senate, such as the Orders of the Day, the Annual Report of the Senate, etc. The information regarding educational qualification of Senators have been taken as available from the official website of the Senate of Pakistan. In some cases, official websites and/or social media pages of Senators have been used and in some, their nomination forms. This information has been provided only to the extent available. In the case of some senators, no information was available regarding educational qualification from these sources.

Number of Committee Memberships and Percentage Attendance of Committee Meetings of Senators take into account all categories of Committees (such as Standing, Functional, Other, etc.) that were active during the 13th Parliamentary year of the Senate.

The performance and record of the honourable Members of Parliament is a key indicator of the performance of our democracy, democratic process and the democratic institutions. These Score Cards seek to provide the citizens of Pakistan with some critical information in order to empower them to monitor their elected representatives and to identify the prospective future political leadership of Pakistan.

Appendix A carries a rank-wise list of the entire 102 Senators. Senators with the same ranks have been placed in alphabetical order of their first name.

Appendix B carries a province/Territory wise list of the entire 102 Senators starting from highest to lowest ranks.

The Honourable Chairman of the Senate, Senator Raza Rabbani (Sindh, PPP-P) and the Honourable Deputy Chairman, Senator Molana Abdul Ghafoor Haideri (Balochistan, JUI-F), have not been included in the assessment exercise as their powers and functions differ greatly from that of a regular member of the Senate.

Federal Ministers have not been scored in the parameter on Number of Committees Chaired, as the rules do not allow them to be elected as Chairmen of a standing committee and most of the other committees.

Rationale

Parliament is one of the key pillars of democracy and a well-informed public is a prerequisite to any functioning democracy. The Senate is one of the two houses of the parliament representing the federating units. The 18th Constitutional Amendment has enhanced the role and functions of the Senate of Pakistan. The Senate, which had earlier consisted of a total of 100 seats increased to 104 with the addition of 4 seats for non-Muslims, one from each Province. The four provinces are equally represented in the Senate of Pakistan with 23 seats each, membership from FATA with 8 seats and the Federal Capital with 4 seats. Of the 23 seats allocated to each province, 14 are general; 4 are reserved for women, 4 for technocrats and after the 18th Amendment and effective from March 2012, 1 seat for non-Muslims.

The performance and record of the honourable Members of Parliament is a key indicator of the strength of our democracy, democratic process and the democratic institutions. These Score Cards seek to provide the citizens of Pakistan with some critical information in order to empower them to monitor their elected representatives. The Score Cards are unique in that they offer objective, reliable and transparent means to see how the honourable Senators of Pakistan perform in the Plenary Sessions of the Senate and the Senate Committees. Through this dissemination of precise, objective and comprehensive information about each of the currently elected Senator of Pakistan, PILDAT hopes to contribute to greater transparency and greater democratic accountability in Pakistan.

The Senators are among the top elected political leaders of Pakistan. Developing this scorecard is also an effort to map the future political leadership of the country for the top-most office.

The performance Score Cards of Senators focus on three main aspects of the Role of a Senator: **Oversight, Legislation and Representation.**

The honourable Senators are able to fulfil their roles and responsibilities as advocates for the interests of their respective province, political party and their country by attending the plenary sessions of the Senate of Pakistan and participating in the activities and meetings of Senate Committees.

Each Senator is obligated to attend the plenary sessions as they provide them with a forum to represent their province, raise critical issues and debate upon the country's challenges. For this purpose, the scorecard highlights the attendance of a Senator in the plenary sessions.

A lot of the work is also being done in the Senate Committees especially pertaining to oversight such as review of bills, constitutional amendments, budgetary recommendations and the like. For the purpose of highlighting this work, the Score Card features committee memberships and attendance in committee meetings of a Senator.

Key objectives of assessing the performance of a Senator of Pakistan is to provide citizens of Pakistan with objective and analytical information about their political leaders' performance in order to make informed choices at the time of election, to assess performance of Pakistan's political leadership so as to enhance public focus and critical appraisal of the leaders that will help future leadership development, to assess gaps, if any, in political leadership skills so that contribution may be made towards efforts, if required, of capacity building and ultimately to enhance transparency and accountability in Pakistan.

Methodology of Assessment

This report consisting of performance Score Cards is based on a collection of data through a series of quantitative methods of data collection. An indigenous framework of assessment was devised by PILDAT consisting of 10 parameters against which data was collected for each Senator. Data request forms were initially drafted and sent to the Secretariat of the Senate of Pakistan. However, as data on individual Senator's contribution on all the parameters devised by PILDAT was not being maintained by the Senate of Pakistan, PILDAT took on the task of extracting information through various means available on the official website of the Senate, such as Orders of the Day, Hansard, Annual Report of the Senate, etc.

The information on educational qualification of Senators has been taken as available from the official website of the Senate of Pakistan. In some cases, official websites and/or social media pages of Senators have been used and in some, their nomination forms.

Number of Committee Memberships and Percentage Attendance of Committee Meetings of Senators take into account all categories of Committees (such as Standing, Functional, Other, etc.) that were active during the 13th Parliamentary year of the Senate.

Scoring Mechanism:

After the data was compiled, a scoring mechanism was devised by PILDAT in which averages of each parameter across all the senators were calculated. A scale of 1-5 was initially selected to score a Senator on each of the 10 parameters.

The formula for score assignment is as under:

1. If value for a parameter is higher by 2 Standard Deviations than the average value (across the 102 Senators), then a score of 5 will be assigned.
2. If value for a parameter is higher by 1 Standard Deviation than the average value (across the 102 Senators), then a score of 4 will be assigned.
3. If value for a parameter is equal to average value (across the 102 Senators), then a score of 3 will be assigned.
4. If value for a parameter is lower by 1 Standard Deviation than the average value (across the 102 Senators), then a score of 2 will be assigned.
5. If value for a parameter is lower by 2 Standard Deviations than the average value (across the 102 Senators), then a score of 1 will be assigned.

These scores were generated using the min/max technique and then aggregated to arrive at a final score out of 5.

After each score out of 5 was generated, weightages were assigned to each parameter as it was realized that some parameters carried, in the opinion of PILDAT, greater value in evaluation of the performance of a Senator. For instance, parameters relating to committee memberships and chairmanships have been assigned lesser weightage compared to the other parameters in the Oversight category. This has been done keeping in mind that parameters such as 'Committee Attendance' and 'Number of Resolutions/Adjournment motions passed' are more reflective of the participation during Senate proceedings. Similarly, the parameters in the 'Legislation' category have been assigned a higher weightage taking in to consideration that legislative activities such as the drafting of a private bill require a much greater effort and initiative from the Senators. Passage of a private member's bill will require even greater effort. Final weighted percentage scores were then calculated and ranks assigned. The assessment framework and the weightage of each parameter is presented in a later section of the report.

Based on the final scores and the ranks, PILDAT has categorized the Senators into the following:

- 1) Senator of the Year
- 2) Top 5 Ranks
- 3) Top 5 Ranks among Women Senators
- 4) Top Performer in Legislation
- 5) Top Performer in Oversight
- 6) Top Performer in Representation
- 7) Province/Territory with the highest percentage of top-performing Senators
- 8) Political Party with the highest number of top-performing Senators

Appendix A carries a list of all the 102 Senators rank wise. Senators with the same ranks have been placed in alphabetical order of their first name.

Appendix B carries a province/Territory wise list of the entire 102 Senators starting from highest to lowest ranks.

The Chairman and Deputy Chairman of the Senate have not been included in the assessment exercise as their powers and functions differ greatly from that of a regular member of the Senate. Federal Ministers have not been scored in the parameter on Number of Committees Chaired, as the rules do not allow them to be elected as Chairmen of the Senate Standing Committees and most of the other committees.

Framework of Assessment of the Performance of a Senator of Pakistan

An indigenous 10-point framework has been devised by PILDAT to assess the performance of a Senator in the Senate of Pakistan. Weightage has also been assigned to each parameter of the framework. The framework has been divided into three broad pillars: **Oversight**, **Legislation** and **Representation**. Each parameter has been phrased in the form of a question. Weightage of each parameter is indicated against it within parenthesis. The Framework is presented below:

Oversight

1. What is the number of the Committees of which the Senator is a member? **(5%)**
2. What is the number of the Committees chaired by the Senator? **(5%)**
3. What is the Attendance of the Senator in his/her Committee(s)? **(10%)**
4. What is the number of Adjournment Motions presented by the Senator? **(10%)**
5. What is the number of Resolutions presented by the Senator? **(10%)**
6. What is the number of Call Attention Motions moved by the Senator? **(10%)**
7. What is the number of Questions asked by the Senator? **(5%)**
(The above data from 4 to 6 has been collected for both cases i.e. (a) when the Senator is the sole mover and (b) when the Senator is the co-mover)

Legislation

8. What is the number of Private Member Bills introduced by the Senator as a sole mover and as a co-mover? **(15%)**
9. What is the number of the introduced Private Member Bills passed by the Senate? **(15%)**

Representation

10. What is the Attendance of the Senator in the Plenary Sessions of the Senate of Pakistan? **(15%)**

3. An Adjournment Motion is for the purpose of discussing a definite matter of recent and urgent public importance that may be made with the consent of the Chairman
4. A Resolution is for the purpose of discussing and expressing an opinion on a matter of general public interest and includes a resolution specified in the Constitution
5. A member may call the attention of a Minister to any matter of urgent public importance and the Minister may make a brief statement or ask for time to make a statement at a later hour or date
6. "Starred Question" means a question for an oral answer and "Unstarred Question" means a question for a written answer
7. A Bill is a legislative proposal in a distinct format, which becomes an Act of Parliament if passed by both the Houses and assented to by the President. Bills can be broadly categorized as private member Bills and Government Bills. Private member means a member other than a Minister or an Adviser.
